In recognition of his outstanding policework, Police Officer Robert Young was named the 84th Precinct's "Officer of the Month" for March.

At the April meeting of the 84th Precinct Community Council, Young was presented with a plaque commemorating his honor.

Young, an officer with the Brooklyn Warrant Divi-

sion, received the honor for apprehending a narcotic supplier operating out the Farragut Houses apartment complex.

On March 15, Young went to an address in the Farragut Houses where the suspect was believed to be. Young was there to apprehend the suspect for multiple outstanding warrants, ranging from criminal pos-

session of a weapon to assault.

As Young attempted to gain access to the apartment, the suspect threw out of the window a sawed-off shotgun, an M1 Carbine, two more shotguns, 24 vials of crack, and some heroin.

Young subsequently took the suspect into custody.
